

National Breast Cancer Foundation Pink Ribbon Travel Competition 2009

Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these conditions of entry. Entry into this promotion is deemed acceptance of these conditions of entry.
2. To enter, Pink Ribbon Breakfast (PRB) Hosts and Pink Ribbon Champions (PRC) must complete the entry question as part of their registration process. Online donors to PRB and PRC must complete the entry question as part of the donation process. Community Fundraising (CF) Hosts and Guests from PRB and CF events must log on to www.nbcf.org.au/travel09, and complete the online entry form in full, including the supporter number supplied by the event host. All mandatory fields - marked with an asterisk (*) - are required to be completed for the entry to be considered valid.
3. This is a game of skill, chance plays no part in determining the winner. Each entry will be individually judged based on its literary and creative merit and originality.
4. To be eligible for entry, entrants must do at least one of the following:

 - Attend a Pink Ribbon Breakfast during the promotion period;
 - Register as a Pink Ribbon Champion on www.pinkribbon.org.au
 - Register to host a Community Fundraising event to be held during the promotion period. To register go to www.nbcf.org.au, click 'Get Involved' and 'Fundraising activities' to download the application forms;.
 - Attend a registered Community Fundraising event during the promotion period and complete the online entry form in full, including the supporter number supplied by the Community Fundraising event host at www.nbcf.org.au/travel09. All mandatory fields - marked with an asterisk (*) - are required to be completed for the entry to be considered valid.
5. Entry is open to Australian residents only, aged 18 years or older. Employees and immediate families of the Promoter and suppliers, providers and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter.
